

WHAT IS OVERSIGHT.GOV?

Oversight.gov was created by the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE) to consolidate in one place all public reports from Federal Offices of Inspector General (OIGs) in order to improve the public's access to independent and authoritative information about the Federal Government. The site includes a publicly accessible, text searchable repository of reports published by OIGs.

WHY DID CIGIE CREATE AN OPEN RECOMMENDATIONS PAGE?

Every year, OIG recommendations result in potential cost savings that amount to billions of dollars. In FY 2019, with the OIG community's aggregate budget of approximately \$2.5 billion, these potential savings represented an approximate \$16 return on every dollar invested in the OIGs. The potential savings total included:

- **\$29.2 billion in potential savings from audit recommendations**, and
- **\$11.6 billion from investigative receivables and recoveries.**

Up until the creation of the Open Recommendations page, there was no single, public repository of these savings. Such a page was necessary to better inform Congress and the public about the actions agencies can take to improve shortcomings in government programs.


